### **Old business:**

- **Water Fountains** – Alison spoke with Buddy on the condition of the water fountains. Buddy has agreed to fix the holes in the walls where the water fountain was on the south side of the pool house. Once that is complete, there is no need for 2 water fountains on the same building. He has cleaned the other 2 water fountains (on the north side of the pool house and on the playground). We will have to replace the one on the pool house probably next year. Buddy will replace the ‘guts’ on the water fountain on the playground.
- **Tennis Court Lifts** – Per Roger Bennett, Premier Tennis Courts Inc. has agreed to do the tennis court lifts for the same price as quoted in his proposal dated March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2005. That price came to \$9,600 for 2 courts. Roger is now back from vacation and will follow up with Lee Brock of Premier Tennis to get something in writing.

### **New Business:**

- **Fall Festival** – We are looking into doing a kids fall festival in early November. We would like to have pony rides, hay rides, cupcake decorating, face painting and a few other fun things for the kids. Heather will look into the costs of the ponies and the face painter. We will discuss more at our next meeting.
- **Bobby Raulerson** – Bobby is the Assistant Football coach at Providence. He is a Woods Resident. He attended the meeting to request the use of the community pool for one morning in late July / early August. He would like to run the football players from Providence into the Woods. He will then do calisthenics on the field and allow the kids to swim for about hour. He has agreed to hire a lifeguard if needed. He would use the pool prior to its 10 a.m. opening. After some discussion, the Recreation Committee unanimously voted to allow Providence to use the pool assuming they hire a lifeguard.
