

2007 Recreation Committee Minutes

A regular meeting of the 2007 Recreation Committee was held on **May 22nd, 2007** at The Woods Community Center. Alison Garcia, the chairperson for the committee, was present and the meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Old business:

- **2008 Budget** – We are working on getting a 2008 budget to the Finance Committee by August. Alison had put a budget together and it was discussed line item by line item. We will work on it more at the next meeting (with more people present) and have it finalized.
- **July 4th Party** – The July 4th party will be Wednesday July 4th from 11-2 p.m. Publix will donate \$1,000 worth of food and beverages. We have reserved a water slide and snow cone machine from Space Walk. Ice man will provide the ice. Alison will ask for \$1,000 from the Board in the event that it is needed. Based on our estimated prices so far (roughly \$500.00), we should not need that much.
- **Tennis Court Lifts** – Per Roger Bennett, Premier Tennis Courts Inc. has agreed to do the tennis court lifts for about the same price as their previous proposal in 2005. Alison is still waiting on Roger to get something in writing.

New Business:

- **Tennis Rules Sign** – It has become apparent that we need signs on the tennis court fences with a few basic rules. It has come to our attention that residents are letting their animals run free within the fences and are also wearing inappropriate shoes. Both of these items are destroying the tennis courts. Alison will get with Roger Bennett to limit the rules to 4 or 5. Then she will get with Caryn to get a cost
- **Water Fountains** – The water fountains by the pool / tennis courts need to be

- changed. One of them is now missing all together. Alison will get prices on these. Water fountains are in the 2007 budget.
- **Bathroom Cleanliness** – Some Woods residents have been complaining about the cleanliness of the pool restrooms. Alison will talk to Karen about how often they get cleaned.
 - **Reserving Picnic Areas** - There was some discussion about reserving the picnic areas and having to fill out a form. It was decided that this would be hard to monitor and may cause problems if 2 parties were reserving the picnic areas back to back. We have no one on sight over the weekend and in the evenings to ensure that all the rules are enforced. We decided that it would be best to publish the rules in the Woodsette and keep it as a first come, first serve area.
