Greetings from the Board of Directors

We are happy to report that The Woods Association closed out 2008 on a solid financial footing. The reserve funds are now funded at 100% and we were able to forego any increase in annual assessment of 2009. You should be aware of the fact that total delinquencies for the month ending February 2009 is at a high of \$71,573.63. Of this amount just over \$34,000.00 is for home owners who are delinquent on their January payment. The remaining \$37,000.00 are delinquencies of twelve home owners and these accounts are in the hands of our lawyer.

There are currently many road improvement projects going on around us and the Board is working with Councilman Clark to ensure that both the Sandalwood Canal and Hodges widening are completed to the satisfaction of The Woods. Inside The Woods we are in the final stage of signing a contract to have the intersection of Woods Drive and Woods Drive North taken up the repaired to correct the pothole problems in this area. This will require that the road be closed to traffic while the work is in progress. We are attempting to have this work done during School spring break (March 30 – April 3) to minimize the impact of this project.

Jacksonville Sheriff's Office has increased their presence in the Woods to help us enforce the 25 mile per hour speed limit and ensure stop signs are obeyed. We are sure that all residents appreciate this effort and want to keep our streets safe for our children, joggers and walkers.

The general rules have been reviewed and approved by The Board and you may obtain a copy from the office. These rules cover parking, architecture, recreation, pool and tennis court topics to name a few. A copy of the general rules should answer the majority of your questions.

The Woods Community recreational areas are for the enjoyment of all residents and we ask that you do your part in keeping these areas clean.

ROAD CLOSING MARCH 30TH

The Woods Drive at the island will be closed to all traffic for about 4 days to repair potholes and sprinkler system. Residents living on Rabbit Run Lane, The Woods Drive, Greenmeadow Place, Firethorn, Squirrel Tree Court, Spiceberry Drive and Circles and Loquat Lane can continue to use the Atlantic Gate. All others use the Hodges Gate.
